Burleigh Golf Club, founded in 1950 and centrally located in Miami is a private members club offering first class championship golf and clubhouse facilities. The club has extensive practice facilities including driving range, putting and chipping greens, bunker area and driving nets.

Cadet & Junior membership is now open to both males and females aged between 7 and 17 years is eligible.

The Junior Programs are run by the club's PGA golf professional Jamie Brew and Junior Golf Coordinator Nathan Main, also a PGA member.

Cadet & Junior members enjoy the following benefits and privileges:

- Being part of the 'Burleigh Birdies' Junior Academy
- Play on the 18-hole golf course at designated times
- Free use of Junior practice balls on the practise facilities including driving range, putting and chipping greens, bunker area and driving nets.
- Free 'Burleigh Birdies' Junior Academy logoed golf shirt/hat
- Free post round clinic after Sunday morning competition focusing on common errors noticed that day by the PGA professional.
- All Cadet & Junior members receive a Certificate of Achievement at the year end which will detail their progress through the year.
- Experienced PGA professionals for lessons, clinics, club fitting and game improvement programs
- Regular weekly competitions with prizes awarded
- Cadet & Junior membership Monthly Medal competitions with prizes and a BBQ lunch after the round.
- Invitation to the Junior Presentation Night held each season
- Cadet & Junior member preferred pricing on golf equipment and accessories through the Pro Shop
- Monthly Cadet & Junior member eNews

PROGRAM OUTLINE

STRUCTURE

All new applicants begin as Cadet members and are first introduced to the club through the Sunday morning 9-hole competition. Their skill level is assessed by one of our PGA professionals, and subject to this initial assessment will commence with the 4-hole program and progress to the 7-hole and then the 9-hole competitions.

Once a Cadet member is playing 9-holes regularly and the PGA professionals deem them ready, he/she can begin attempting to play 18 holes. This is their opportunity to apply for and obtain a Golf Australia handicap, progress to Junior membership and be eligible to play in other club competitions and regional Junior events.

Junior members are encouraged to play in club competitions with members and are eligible to play in the Club Championships. Juniors teams are entered in the district interclub and pennant events.

Regular group clinics are offered for Cadet & Junior members to encourage them and aid in improving their game. These are run concurrently with the program year to make certain Cadets & Junior members have access to PGA professionals at relevant times.

TIMINGS

Cadet & Junior members can play in the Sunday morning Junior Competition which is run every week from early February to early December with tee times from 7.30am onwards. All players should be ready to play at 7.30am with a daily draw being done by the PGA professional.

COACHING AND CLINICS

Burleigh Golf Club is fortunate to have the services of PGA professionals at its disposal. Jamie Brew, a member of the Queensland PGA Board, has many years experience in coaching and is one of the most respected PGA Professionals in the country.

CLINICS

On a fortnightly basis, Jamie Brew conducts a clinic for all Cadet & Junior golfers at the conclusion of the Sunday morning completion. There is no need to book in advance for these clinics.

In addition, clinics are held on Thursday afternoons from 3.45pm until 4.30pm focusing on a different aspect of the game. As demand dictates extra days will be added to accommodate everyone. Numbers per clinic are restricted due to the limited practise facility area, so bookings in advance are essential through the Pro Shop.

All clinics are tailored to the skill level of the group and their content and delivery will change as the skill levels of Cadets & Juniors improve.
